St. Clair County Health Department Offering COVID-19 Vaccination Clinic- April 28

The St. Clair County Health Department is offering a “walk-in” opportunity for COVID-19 vaccination on **Wednesday, April 28 from 9:00am to 6:00pm** at the Knight Club, 1195 Gratiot Blvd, Marysville.

Please note the following:

- **If you already have an appointment, keep that time.**
- **Do not come to the clinic if sick or not feeling well; or are in isolation or quarantine.**
- **Open to those *who live and/or work* in St. Clair County.**
- **Moderna vaccine (first dose)**
- **18 and up (Moderna first dose)**
- **900 doses available during walk-in hours.**
- **Forms will be handed out in the parking lot and will need to be completed before entering.**
- **Masking is required.**
- **No out of pocket costs.**
- **Plan for at least 1 hour and dress accordingly.**
- **Lines will be socially distanced, however, there may be a wait time depending on volume.**
- **If the parking lot is full, please come back later.**

Jennifer Michaluk, Public Information Officer for the St. Clair County Health Department stated; “If you haven’t been vaccinated yet, the St. Clair County Health Department is offering another walk-in opportunity for anyone 18 and older. Walk-in, get vaccinated and leave knowing you are helping do your part in protecting yourself and others in our community.”
