Thursday, May 6:

• Marysville Fire Department, 1355 Delaware, Marysville. <u>Schedule appointment</u>. Drive-ups welcome. 3:00pm-6:00pm. Pfizer vaccine. 16 and older. Parental consent needed for those under 18 years old.

Saturday, May 8:

• St Clair County Better Together/Diversity Initiative at Harvey Reinvestment Center, 3013 24th Street, Port Huron. 10:00am-4:00pm. Moderna vaccine. 18 and older.
