### ***St. Clair County Health Department Resumes Walk-in Rapid COVID-19 Testing***

The St. Clair County Health Department (SCCHD) will resume “walk-in” rapid COVID-19 testing on Wednesday, January 19. Quantities are limited. We recommend testing for individuals who are sick, have symptoms, or on day 5 after exposure regardless of symptoms.

“Walk-in” rapid COVID-19 testing is a self-testing process using a testing kit located outside of the building. Testing must be done onsite at the time of visit and is completed from an individual’s car (or outside of the building). Appointments are strongly encouraged. Schedule an appointment on the website [www.scchealth.co](http://www.scchealth.co) or call (810) 987-5300. Testing hours are Mondays, 10:30am - 6:00pm and Tuesday through Friday, 8:30am - 4:00pm
